Dear Parents,

I feel incredibly blessed to be able to teach Bible class to the children. In October Bible class, we used the story of Noah's Ark to teach the two-year-old students about their monthly manner – taking turns and the three-year-old students about their virtue – patience. The animals had to be patient and wait their turn to enter Noah's ark two by two. The twos and threes had fun with our large wooden ark and letting the animals take turns entering. The students also helped tell the story of Noah's ark with an interactive felt board. They all learned about the meaning of the rainbow – that God always keeps His promises.

I read the Parable of the Pumpkin with the K-4's and 5's students. Then we read the Pumpkin Prayer together as we constructed a perfect pumpkin. I am so impressed with how well our K-4- and 5-year-old students are doing with learning the 10 Commandments. Ask your K-4 and 5-year-old preschooler to tell you the first two commandments. They even have motions to go with them.

Thank you to all the parents who helped their children complete and read the "Hail Mary" coloring page at home. Over 50 students returned them. I was so proud of them!

It is a true joy to share all the rich treasures of our Catholic faith with your children.
